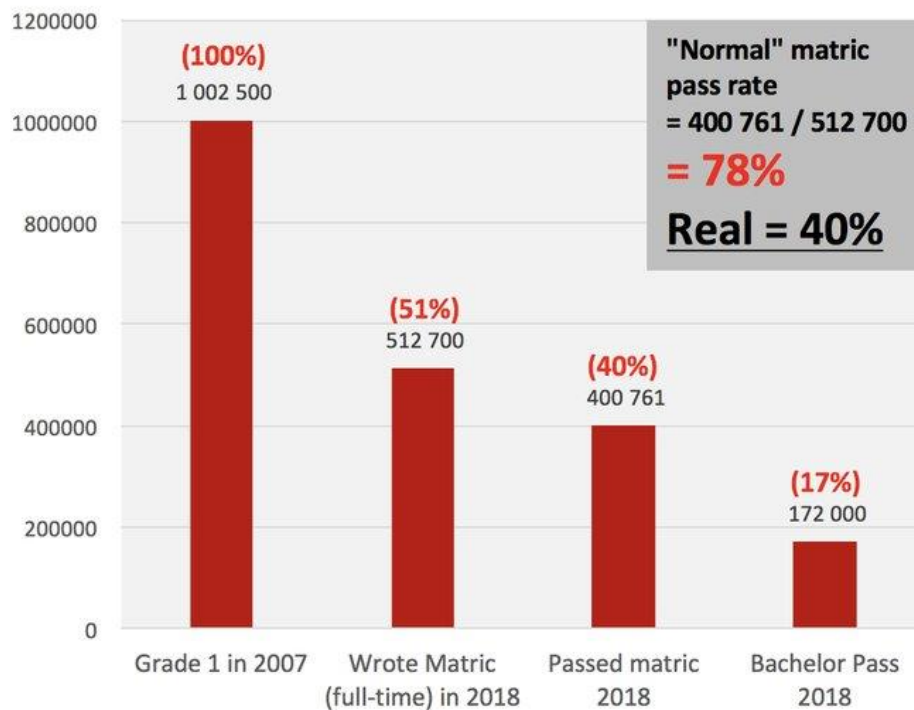
3. Course duration

4. National reflection

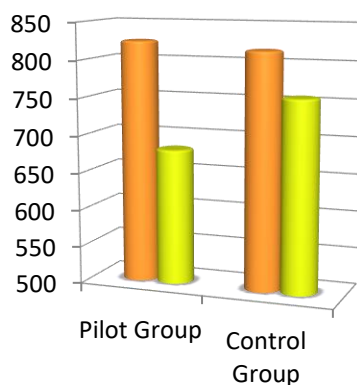
According to education economist Nicholas Spaull, the conclusion was made that far too little learners matriculate in South Africa:
